

Post-Graduate Survey Class of 2023 Highlights

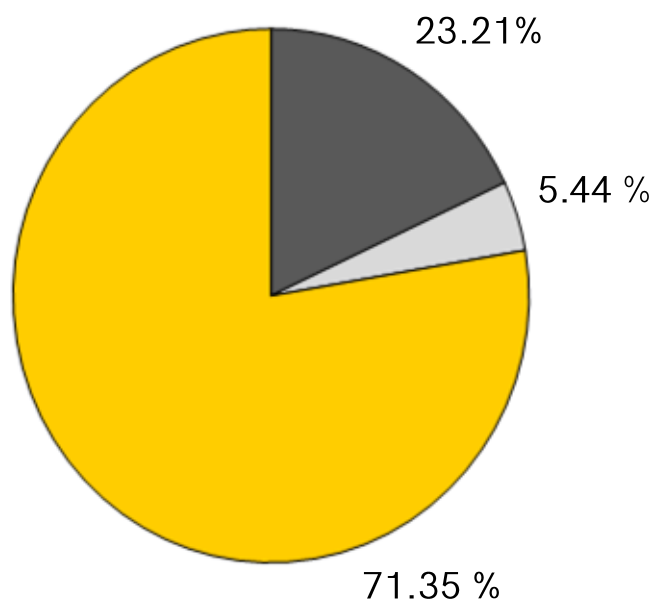
ABOUT THE SURVEY

The Class of 2023 Post-Graduate Survey was conducted by the Southwestern University Center for Career & Professional Development (CCPD). Data collection took place between April prior to May Commencement and continued through the following March, and includes surveys at Commencement, via email prior to and after Commencement, via follow-up phone calls, and from outcomes data published by graduates online. Of the 375 graduates from December 2022, May 2023 and August 2023 who make up this reporting class, the CCPD obtained information on 349 (93 percent of the class).

71.35 % Employed

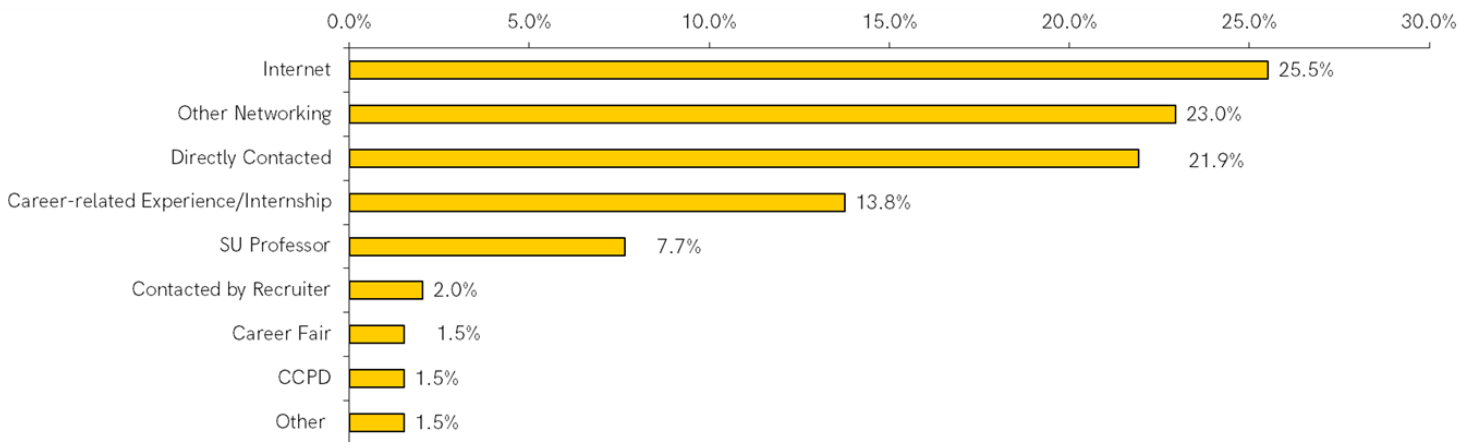
23.21 % Graduate/Professional School or

Three quarters of all survey respondents reported entering the world of work upon graduation.

Where are they working?

The majority (85 percent) of respondents work in Texas, while 13 percent work in 15 other states and two percent work internationally in three countries (Spain, Sweden, and the United Kingdom. Less than one percent work remotely.

The most frequently represented work locations are:

- 85.0 % Texas
- 2.9 % California
- 1.2% Colorado
- 1.2 % Washington, DC
- 1.2 % Florida

What do they earn?

Respondents working full-time who reported annual salaries earn:

- \$52,045 on average
- \$50,000 median salary
- \$12,720-\$125,000 range

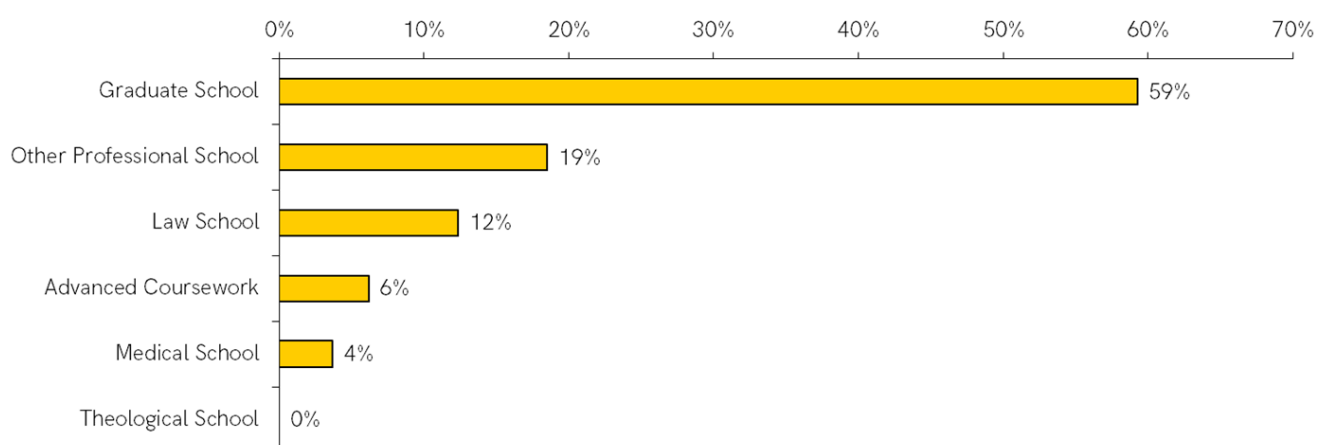
