

Post-Graduate Survey Class of 2024 Highlights

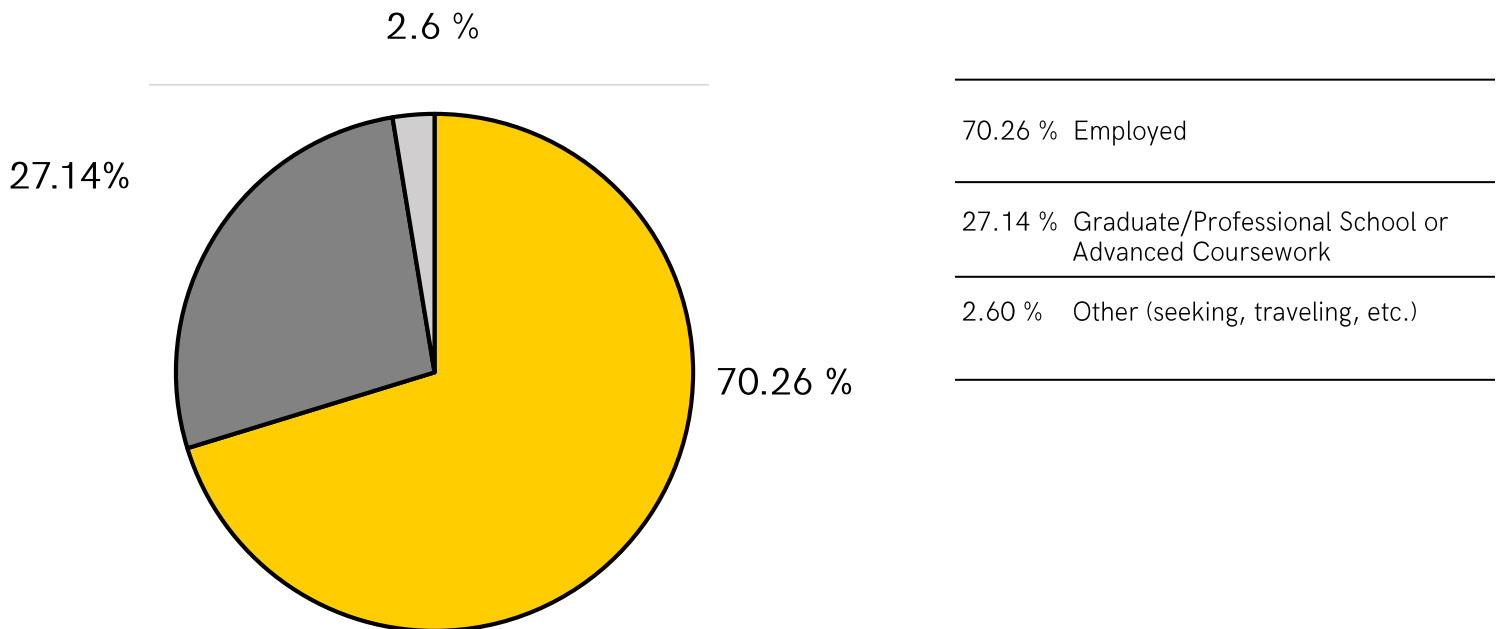
ABOUT THE SURVEY

The Class of 2024 Post-Graduate Survey was conducted by the Southwestern University Center for Career & Professional Development (CCPD). Data collection took place between April prior to May Commencement and continued through the following March, and includes surveys at Commencement, via email prior to and after Commencement, via follow-up phone calls, and from outcomes data published by graduates online. Of the 312 graduates from December 2023, May 2024 and August 2024 who make up this reporting class, the CCPD obtained information on 269 (86.2 percent of the class).

WHERE IS THE CLASS OF 2024 NOW?

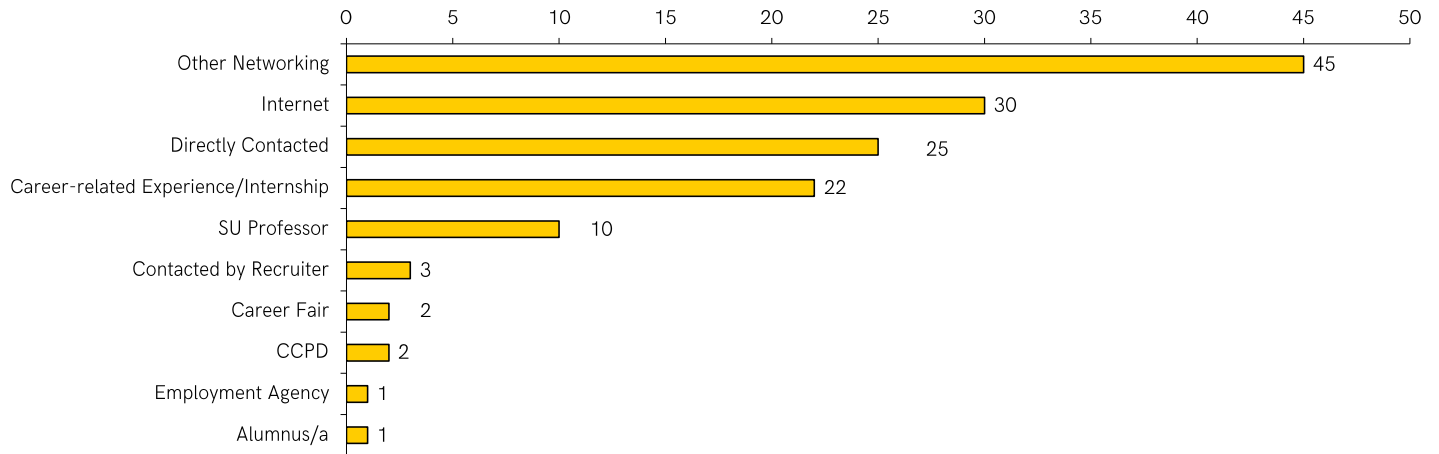
Respondents reported their primary activity after graduation as:

The majority (85 percent) of respondents work in Texas, while 10 percent work in 11 other states and five percent work internationally in five countries (Japan, Mexico, New Zealand, South Africa and Spain).

The most frequently represented work locations are:

- 1.1% Colorado
- 1.1 % Missouri
- 1.1 % North Carolina
- 1.1 % Washington

Respondents working full-time who reported annual salaries earn:

- \$53,353 on average
- \$50,000 median salary
- \$23,400 - \$110,000 range

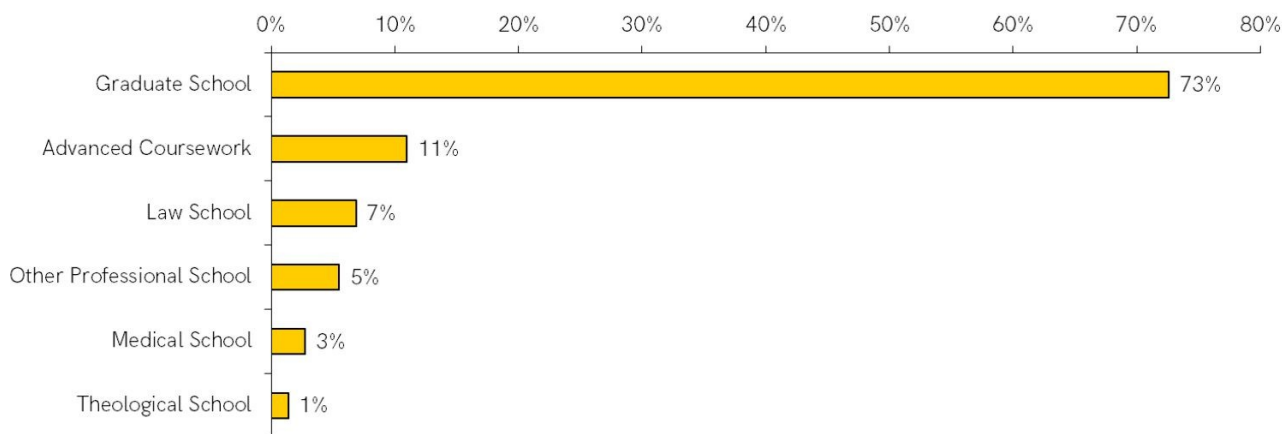

- 17.82 % Both paid and unpaid internship experience
