Brief Description of Organization (mission/purpose, types of clients served, services provided):

The Central Texas Treatment Center is a 100-bed residential treatment center for probationers with chemical dependency problems. Its main mission and purpose is to successfully treat residents through cognitive-behavioral therapy in which residents begin to practice cognitive self change. Its clients include nonviolent drug and alcohol offenders with either felonies or misdemeanors. At the center they provide classes on topics such as anger management and thinking true thoughts instead of just the basic drug and alcohol 101 classes.

Intern Duties & Responsibilities (list):

- Observe classes and large group meetings.
- Observe intake and assessment process for new residents.
- Interview two residents: one brand new and one near completion of the program.
- Attend at least one Al-Anon, NA, or AA meeting in Georgetown.
- Conduct a urinalysis and full body pat down on a female resident returning to the facility.
