Brief Description of Organization (mission/purpose, types of clients served, services provided):

HOPE Community Services is a mental health center in Oklahoma City, OK that provides outpatient behavioral health services. Programs at HOPE include case management, individual/group therapy, housing/community living, psychiatric rehabilitation services, a medication clinic, crisis intervention, trauma and vocational services. HOPE also has programs designed for criminal offenders and clients who have cooccurring disorders. To assist consumers in meeting their needs, HOPE works with several community providers such as the Department of Corrections and the Department of Human Services. Although anyone experiencing mental health problems can receive services from HOPE, nearly all of the clients served are low income-many of which are poverty level and have Social Security or Medicaid. A lot of clients at HOPE are homeless.

HOPE Mission Statement: "To be a progressive leader in the community providing innovative and supportive mental health and addiction programs that are responsive, efficient, and effective in delivering trauma and recovery focused services that improve the quality of life for children, families, and adults in our community"
